**Brief Overview:** Dr. Glen Sharpe, Associate Professor, Nipissing University's Schulich Faculty of Education will be providing a workshop on identifying age-inappropriate/appropriate sexual behaviours in elementary-aged children, teacher reactions to concerning sexual behaviours (eg. documentation, consultations) and working with parents. Case studies will be presented and reflected upon via small group discussions. A certificate of participation will be provided for all who attend.

**Target Participants:** Professionals currently working with children in an elementary school setting; for example, teachers, school social workers, school counselors, child and youth workers, early childhood educators, teaching assistants, and other school personnel.
